On December 4, the U.S.-Africa Business Center hosted H.E. Fayez al-Serraj, the Prime Minister of Libya, for a roundtable discussion with the private sector. The Prime Minister and his delegation reviewed the government's reconstruction plan and highlighted its priorities to strengthen the economy and bolster security across the country. The Chamber stressed the importance of economic development in maintaining security and curbing terrorism post-reconstruction. The Chamber was encouraged by the government's willingness for an open dialogue with the U.S. private sector, and plans to weigh in on the Libya Economic Club which the government will be launching in the coming year.

We will continue to work closely with the Embassy in DC to develop these relationships in order to strengthen the bilateral trade partnership between the United States and Libya.
